notification of WTO on Jun 1, 2021.

According to the specified scope and evaluation screening, the test results of SVHC are ≤ 0.1% (w/w) in the submitted sample.	Pass

2. REACH obligation:

2.1 Concerning article(s):

Communication:

Article 33 of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 requires supplier of an article containing a substance meeting the criteria in Article 57 and identified in accordance with Article 59(1) in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) shall provide the recipient of the article with sufficient information, available to the supplier, to allow safe use of the article including, as a minimum, the name of that substance in the Candidate List.

Notification:

2.2 Concerning material(s):

Test results in this report are based on the tested sample. This report refers to testing result of tested sample submitted as homogenous material(s). Test Method:

With reference to SGS In-House method, analysis was performed by ICP-OES, UV-VIS, GC-MS, HPLC-DAD/MS and Colorimetric Method.
